We are a committee run pre-school in the village of Nether Stowey for children ages 2-5 years. We are a small friendly team committed to providing a nurturing environment that enables all children to achieve their full potential, throughout their formative years.

Job description

As an Early Years Educator you will work as part of the pre-school team under the direction of the Manager to provide safe, high quality education and care for young children.

Whilst the number of guaranteed contractual hours are limited we anticipate there will be future opportunities to increase these for the right candidate.

Main Duties:

- To assist with the delivery of the EYFS curriculum
- To observe, keep records and monitor children's progress
- To advise the Manager of any concerns e.g. over children, parents or the safety of equipment, preserving confidentiality as necessary
- To teach children, offering an appropriate level of support and stimulation
- To ensure that children are kept safe and that you understand when to follow child safeguarding procedures
- To support meal times within the setting, helping to clean and tidy away at the end of sessions and set up for the next day
- To attend in-service training courses and staff / supervision meetings as required
- To keep completely confidential any information regarding the children, their families or other staff which is acquired as part of the job
- To be aware of and adhere to all the settings operational policies and procedures
- To ensure adequate records are kept and updated regularly
- To be an ambassador for the preschool
